HOPE Host Home Program

Community Transitional Housing

90-day housing support with community hosts and dedicated case-management, enabling participants to set and achieve individualized goals that lead to independent, permanent housing. Participants are required to set and work towards stability-building goals to stay enrolled in the program.

Pathways to HOPE Sessions

Pro Se Support

Workshops where asylum-seekers receive comprehensive translation, technical, clerical, and educational resources as they navigate the complex asylum process. Additionally, applicants receive ongoing support including translation of court letters, clock reviews, and filing for work authorization when eligible. Participants are also offered free, virtual assistance with preparing Family Protection Plans.

HOPE Community Services

Partnership Projects

Connects individuals through immigrant volunteer teams at local non-profits. Participants receive education regarding workplace culture, job-specific English-language vocabulary guides, 1:1 resume enhancement and job search support. Career-focused workshops are also offered to develop trade skills like housecleaning or to acquire certifications like CPR & First Aid. Additionally, letters of recommendation and a \$500 grant of appreciation is awarded to each participant.

Crisis to HOPE Fund

Emergency Stabilization

Emergency one-time financial assistance of up to \$500 for critical needs such as legal fees, transportation, rental support, and medical expenses. The award is accompanied with up to 6 hours of individualized case management. This program also includes a 50% EAD matching program to cover the new work permits and asylum fees for people filing pro se through our organization.
